Welcome Swim Club, Inc. Pool Party Request & Guidelines

Pool members who have paid their membership dues In-Full may rent the pool for private parties on Sundays from 6:00PM - 9:00PM, on Fridays and Saturdays from 7:00PM – 10:00PM, or for semi-private parties on Wednesdays and Thursdays from 6:00PM - 9:00PM.

For the semi-private parties the pool will not be closed but you will have private use of the covered area. Be aware on Wednesdays and Thursdays, Swim Team practice will be going on during the same time, limiting three (3) lanes of the pool.

The fee for a private party on Sunday is \$150.00, private party on Fridays and Saturdays is \$225.00, and a semi-private party is \$100.00. We must know the exact number of people before the party date in order to schedule enough lifeguards. If there is going to be more than fifty (50) people swimming, there is an additional \$25.00 charge which is to cover the cost of additional lifeguards.

- Guest passes cannot be used in lieu of scheduling a private or semi-private party. Members are not allowed to combine guest passes with other members at any time to have parties. If any member has more than 8 guests present at anytime it will be considered a semi-private party and the member will be billed for a semi-private party.
- **Party hosts are required to clean up all areas of the pool.** If there is excessive trash and/or the pool areas are left in an unclean manner, a clean up fee will be charged at the pool manager/pool board’s discretion.
- Any guest exhibiting disruptive behavior will be asked to leave the premises and will not be allowed to return at any time during the pool season.
- Access to the pool.
- **Absolutely NO alcoholic beverage on WSC grounds.**
- All rules and regulation as listed in the Rules and Regulations apply for pool parties. Please review prior to booking a party.

All party reservations must be made through the Pool Manager either in-person, via phone, or via email.

To Book your Pool Party please complete the following:

1. Complete the WSC Pool Party Request Form below and email to infowscnc@gmail.com
2. After receiving confirmation that your date is available to be booked by the Pool Manager, you will need to go **online to pay for your party within 24 hours of booking**. If not paid within the 24 hours, the date will be open for anyone to book.

Payment is due at the time your party reservation is made. This can be done via our Online Services or during pool hours at the Lifeguard Station. (if at Lifeguard Station, bring a copy of your confirmation email)

All payments need to be in the form of debit/credit card payment. If an organization is paying for the rental (church, softball team, etc) and needs to do so via a check, make the check payable to “Welcome Swimming Club, Inc.” and include the words “Pool Party” with the date of the party in the memo line.
